TRANSFER OF A FOOD BUSINESS APPLICATION FORM

The Food Act 2008 (the Act) regulates the sale of food for human consumption in Western Australia. If your business sells food you must either register with, or notify, the shire where the premises is located. Regulatory requirements are matched to the level of food safety risk associated with food handling activities at the premises. If you plan to alter the type of food handled at the premises, you should discuss this with the shire as it may alter your food premises classification.
