



# POINT LEANDER DRIVE UPGRADE

Works are soon to commence on resurfacing segments of Point Leander Drive, which will include upgrading a portion of the Foreshore car parking as per the Green Space Initiative community consultation sessions held late last year.

The bulk of the works are scheduled to commence Monday 27 May 2019 and be completed by 30 June 2019. Detailed drawings of the works can be obtained from the Shire Administration Office or the Shire webpage [www.irwin.wa.gov.au](http://www.irwin.wa.gov.au).

The core Foreshore car parking upgrades will be between the boat ramp exit and Granny's Beach roundabout, but excludes the Fisherman's Hall and its surrounding car parks:

## Stage 1- Demolition & Construction

- Removal of vegetation, bollards and kerbing
- Removal of car parking surfaces & refilling with quality soil ready for lawn planting
- Gravel construction of on street car parking
- Relocation of some services and installation of drainage

## Stage 2 – Asphalt Resealing & Car Park Formation

- Boat ramp exit to Granny's Beach roundabout
- Irwin River Bridge (Port Denison side) to approximately Sundew Ave

## Stage 3 – Pedestrian Access & Safety

- Construction of new dual use footpath from Boat ramp exit to Granny's Beach roundabout
- Line marking of road surface
- Installation of signage

To assist residents and motorists, Traffic Management will be in place for the duration of the works.
