

Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban – Register for SMS Notifications



The Shire of Irwin has implemented a notification system, via a mobile phone SMS (text message), to advise of movement bans imposed for **harvesters, vehicles and internal combustion engines**. If a ban has been imposed, registered contacts will be sent a text message advising details of the ban. The system is also utilised to send notifications of a **Total Fire Ban** imposed by Department of Fire Emergency Services. Notifications are also sent for road closures, severe weather events and other emergency notifications.

ABC Radio is still the primary means of notifying farmers of imposed bans and bans will continue to be announced on ABC Radio at 10.00am and 2.00pm. Please note ABC Radio does not advise when bans are lifted. Text messages should not be solely relied upon due to the SMS System not being a guaranteed service from telecommunication companies.
