

Guideline - 03

Independent Living Units Two Henry Road, Port Denison

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants are required to comply with the Shire of Irwin eligibility criteria, which includes the following:

- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- an applicant or applicants must be 65 years or over (non-indigenous decent); or
- 55 years or over (Indigenous Australian decent).

Supporting Documentation

You will need to provide the following documentation when lodging your application:

PROOF OF INCOME

Pension or Benefit

Provide proof of income for yourself and your partner or co-applicant. (Income statement from Centrelink or Department of Veterans Affairs no more than 4 weeks old).

Wage and Salary Earner

Employer Income Verification Statement completed by employer or consecutive wages slips for the past three months.

Self- Employed

Tax assessment from the Australian Taxation Office for the last financial year or proof of income for the past three months.

RENTAL HISTORY

You will need to provide one of the following documents:

- Written reference from previous landlord
- Copy of current rental report
- Copy of current or previous rates notice no more than 12 months old

PROOF OF IDENTITY

Applicants are responsible for establishing their identity and that of their dependents. To prove your identity, you are required to supply documents from the *list on the next page*.

If you are Aboriginal or a Torres Straits Islander and cannot supply these documents, a statement from a recognised Aboriginal organisation confirming your identity is acceptable.



Please provide either:

One (1) document from Category A and one (1) document from Category B or C

OR

If you have no Category A documents, any three (3) documents from either Category B or C will be required.

CATEGORY A

- Australian passport or overseas passport stamped for residency to Australia
- Certificate of Australian Citizenship or Citizen Papers
- Birth certificate or extract issued at least five years ago
- Overseas passport stamped for entry to Australia
- Original Australian birth certificate for claimant issued more than five years ago
- Australian birth extract issued more than five years ago
- Document of identity issued by Department of Foreign Affairs
- Australian Armed Services discharge documents
- Child or partner's original death certificate issued by a government department more than five years ago which shows the applicant's name.

CATEGORY B

- Original Marriage Certificate issued by a Government Department
- Apprenticeship indenture papers
- Tradesperson's Certificate of Proficiency
- Nurses Registration Board documents
- Divorce papers
- Original Birth Certificate or Extract issued between one and five years ago
- Australian Birth Extract issued between one and five years ago
- Tax Assessment Notice
- Life Insurance Policies
- Change of name by Deed Poll more than 12 months old.

CATEGORY C

- Reference or letter from a government department where address matches that on the application
- Bank statement showing transactions for 12 months
- Gas, electricity and phone bills where address matches that on the application
- Prison Discharge certification
- Motor Vehicle registration or license where address matches that on the application
- Legal documents such as: Summons, Bail papers or Traffic Infringement notice, if offered with Motor Vehicle Registration Papers
- Motor Vehicle Registration papers, showing a cash register imprint as long as they show the same address as that on the application.
