This cottage, which was known as "Linga Longa", was built by E. Fields in c.1930 and sold to Eric Heitman in 1940. Later the Jones family used it for summer holidays and during this period the two corrugated iron rooms on the north side were demolished. In the 1950s the Foster family purchased the house. The place was demolished in 2003.
