This house was built for Ernest Fields as a holiday home for his family. Fields was a shopkeeper in Mingenew and when he retired he moved to Port Denison and lived in the house. The Nagel family lived here in the 1940s. Later it was used as a rental house and about 1950 was bought by A. Cousins who operated the BP fuel depot in Port Denison.
