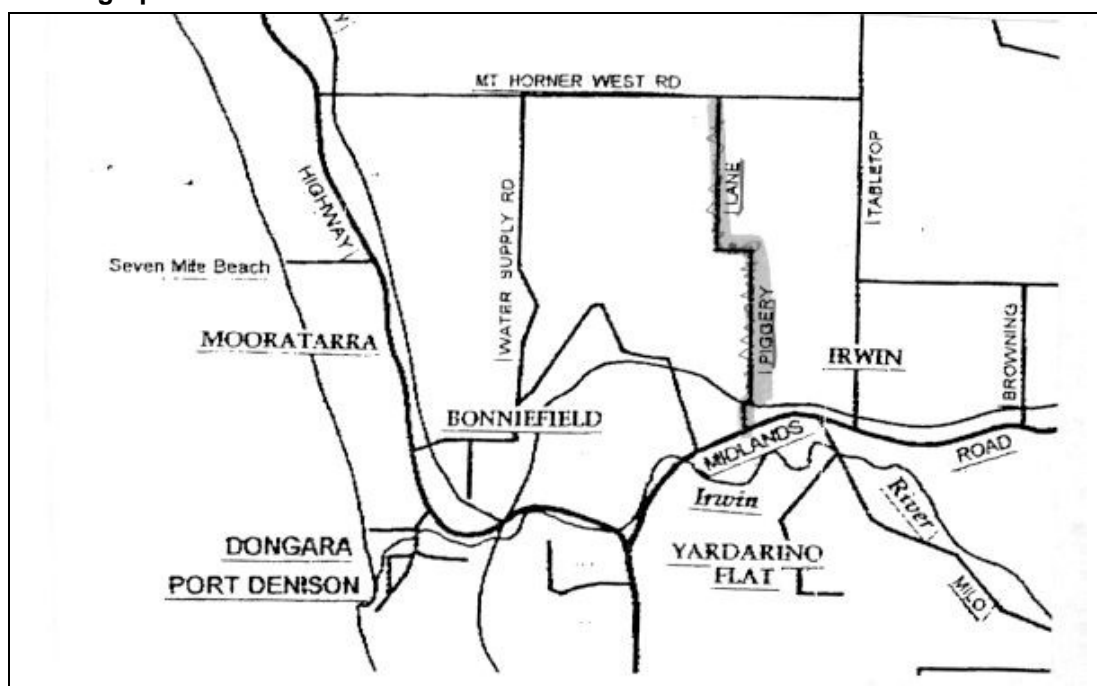

This narrow road was a part of the "Old North Road" that ran from Wanneroo (Padbury's stockyard) to Walkaway and Champion Bay.

It was used by the first settlement party which included L.C. Burges and Major Logue in 1851 who followed the route taken by George Grey. It became a much travelled route for early travellers between Perth and Champion Bay. Piggery Lane was named for the piggery which operated on land north west of the road.
