Background:

At the Ordinary Council Meeting held 24 October 2023, Council appointed the following Council Members as Voting Members on the Shire of Irwin Audit Committee:

Cr Scott

Cr Wyse

Cr Leonard (as proxy)

Section 7.1A of the Local Government Act 1995 states:

'A local government is to establish an Audit Committee of 3 or more persons to exercise the powers and discharge the duties conferred on it.

For the Shire of Irwin to comply with Section 7.1A, a third Councillor will need to be appointed as a full voting member of the Audit Committee.

The Agenda for the Ordinary Council Meeting held 24 October 2023 requested Council appoint four (4) Members to the Audit Committee. Due to an administrative error, a decision was recorded stating

that Council appointed two (2) Voting Members and one (1) Proxy. This decision therefore does not meet the requirements of Section 7.1A of the *Local Government Act 1995*.

Officer's Comment:

Shire Officers held conversations with the Governance team at WALGA who advised that as Decision 061023 has already been enacted, the decision could not be revoked.

WALGA advice was that the Shire hold a Special Council Meeting to amend the membership of the Audit Committee in the first instance to ensure compliance with Section 7.1A of the Local Government Act 1995.

Local Government Act 1995 Division 1 A, section 7.1.A Audit committee

(1) A local government is to establish and audit committee of 3 or more persons to exercise the powers and discharge the duties on it.

The members of the audit committee of a local government are to be appointed* by the local government and at least 3 of the members, and the majority of the members, are to be council members.
