

## Dongara Heritage Walk

The Dongara Heritage Walk is a 4km walk featuring some of Dongara's historic buildings and landmarks. The walk is circular and can be commenced at any of the historic places, taking a couple of hours to complete. Please note: The walk features some private homes and walkers are requested to respect the privacy of residents. Persons using the Heritage Walk do so at their own risk.

The free 20-page Dongara Heritage Walk booklet is being reprinted and will be available in late 2021, in the meantime please use your phone to access the full walk information with our compliments.

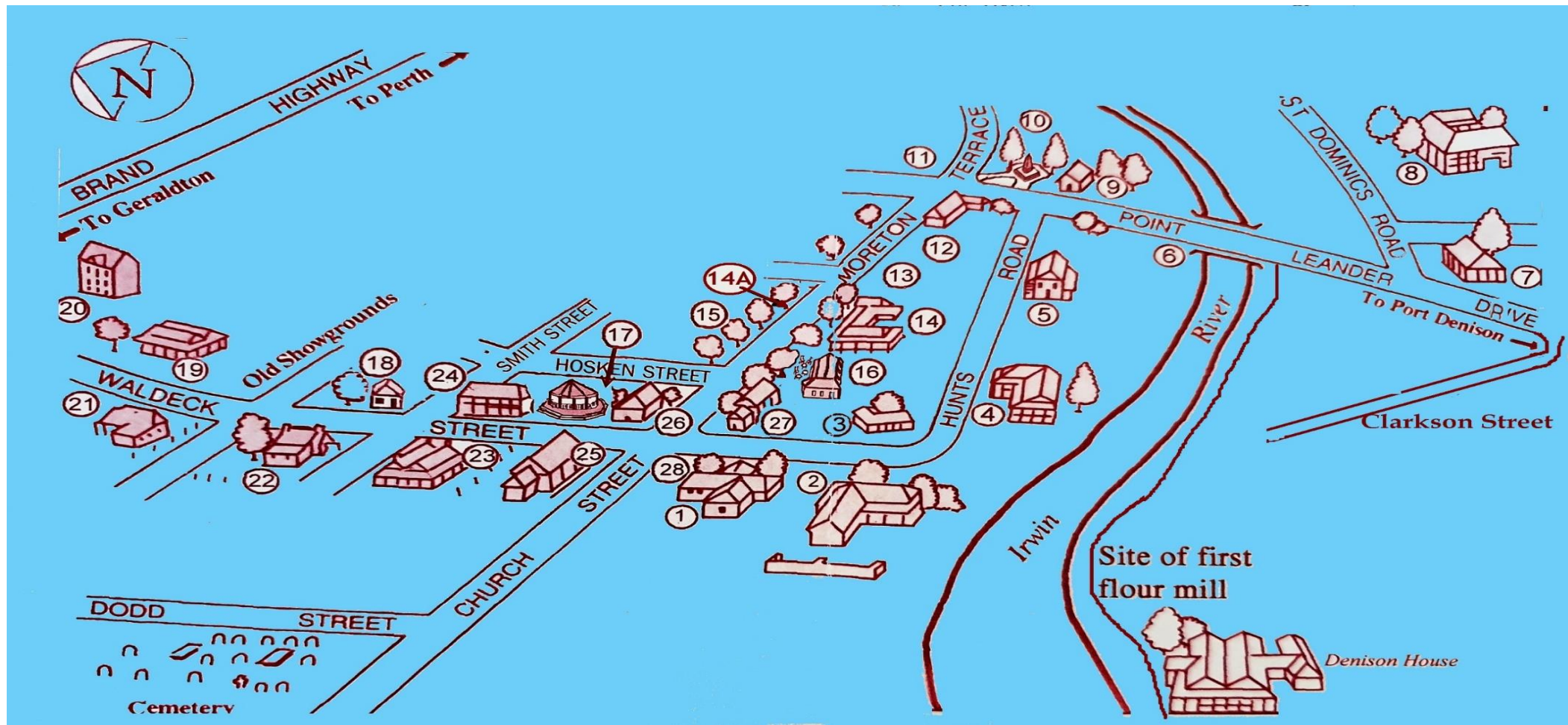
